- *Review*
(1 -2 lessons)
 1. Look at the tours of your partners in VR

OVERALL LISTENING COMPREHENSION

A2 Can understand enough to be able to meet needs of a concrete type provided speech is clearly and slowly articulated.

Can understand phrases and expressions related to areas of most immediate priority provided speech is clearly and slowly articulated

Can understand simple directions relating to how to get from X to Y

B1 Can understand straightforward factual information about common everyday or job-related topics, identifying both general messages and specific details, provided speech is clearly articulated in a generally familiar accent.

Can understand the main points of clear standard speech on familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school, leisure etc., including short narratives.

Can follow detailed directions

OVERALL ORAL PRODUCTION

A2 Can give a simple description or presentation of people, living or working conditions, daily routines, likes/dislikes, etc. as a short series of simple phrases and sentences linked into a list

B1 Can reasonably fluently sustain a straightforward description of one of a variety of subjects within his/her field of interest, presenting it as a linear sequence of points.

Can briefly give reasons and explanations for opinions, plans and actions.

INTERVIEWING AND BEING INTERVIEWED

B1 Can carry out a prepared interview, checking and confirming information, though he/she may occasionally have to ask for repetition if the other person's response is rapid or extended.

Can use a prepared questionnaire to carry out a structured interview, with some spontaneous follow up-questions.

A2 Can make him/herself understood in an interview and communicate ideas and information on familiar topics, provided he/she can ask for clarification occasionally, and is given some help to express what he/she wants to.
